

Missionary Journey Classifications

Level 1

Description: A Level 1 journey is primarily a disciple making and church planting missionary journey. These journeys have a heavy emphasis on gospeling, followed by immediate obedience through disciple making. Our focus is to find persons of peace or houses of peace and equip them to be disciple makers.

Participant Requirements:

- A follower of Christ with a desire to make disciples of the nations
- Approval through the application process
- Participation and completion of Level 1 Missionary Journey Training Process (not required to apply, we provide this training prior to journey).

Ex: A week long journey to work in local communities to prayer walk, share the gospel, and help new disciples take immediate steps of obedience.

Level 2

Description: A Level 2 journey is primarily a training and equipping missionary journey. These journeys have a heavy emphasis on higher level training on disciple making and church planting for disciples who have identified themselves as leaders through their immediate obedience. Our focus is to follow up with disciple makers from a Level 1 journey and help them multiply healthy disciples and healthy churches.

Participant Requirements:

- A follower of Christ with a desire to make disciples of the nations
- Approval through the application process
- Successfully completed at least one Level 1 journey
- Ongoing obedience of Level 1 disciple making principles
- Participation and completion of Level 2 Missionary Journey Training Process (not required to apply, we provide this training prior to journey).

Ex: A weekend journey to train and practice principles with those identified as persons of peace or houses of peace from a Level 1 journey.

Extreme

Description: A journey is classified as extreme due to circumstances based on location or activities necessary to the success of the journey. These could be related to weather, terrain, culture, accommodations, etc.

Participant Requirements:

- All requirements consistent with Level Classification (Level 1 / Level 2)
- Appropriate physical, mental, and/or spiritual health to successfully handle extreme element

Ex: A week long Level 1 missionary journey to a village located at 14,000 ft.

Hands & Feet

Description: A Hands & Feet journey is primarily a service-oriented journey. These journeys have an emphasis on meeting the physical needs in a community in order to share the spiritual love of Jesus (being His hands and feet). Hands & Feet journeys can be the emphasis of a missionary journey or an element of a Level 1 or Level 2 journey.

Participant Requirements:

- A follower of Christ with a desire to make disciples of the nations
- Approval through the application process
- Participation and completion of Hands & Feet Missionary Journey Training Process (not required to apply, we provide this training prior to journey).

Ex: A week long journey to work in a local orphanage through children's ministry and building projects.
